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## **RE: FLIGHT FOR FREEDOM**

Greetings,

I am writing you about my current case for asylum with Migrationsverket.

I have been in Sweden for 3 years. In those 3 years, I have been able to accomplish several milestones:

- I have paid taxes to the Swedish system from the earnings of my work. I am very proud of being able to accomplish this. Making a contribution to the host that granted me solace and security has been an honor.
- I have taken language classes so that I may learn Swedish and better adapt to my new surroundings.
- I have volunteered with different NGO's, contributed to various creative arts, modeling and music organizations, and continue to do so.
- I have attended therapy sessions that provided comfort and reason as I began to recall and face the traumas of sexual, physical, verbal & mental abuse in Sudan. The greatest gift of these sessions was the awareness of meditation which led to a peace within that has always been there.

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These are just a few of the milestones that allowed me to celebrate my growth and breakout from 27 years of imprisonment and a plethora of abuses. I am still uncovering past traumas as I continue to heal.

In the 3 years since I escaped slavery in Sudan, I have had 3 meetings for 3 hours each with Migrationsverket. I have had my case processed by a minimum of 3 different people. In each of these sessions, I do not feel nor have I received a confirmation that my case was any closer to a decision. I am currently unaware of any progress.

My efforts to be informed on the process, led me to your homepage. From your website I have researched answers to basic questions:

- I have submitted an application... now I want to go abroad. How do I go about this?
- How do I request my passport back?

As advised, I submitted my passport to Migrationsverket because it was necessary for my case to begin processing and a work permit to be issued. My travel document expired in 2020. My ability to travel has entered a *grey area* while in the asylum "decision process" I am determined to reach my destination; I am without citizenship and have no status of asylum.

When I escaped the torment of my family and landed in Scandinavia, Sweden was not my final destination. I was scared, scarred and terrified that my family would find me. I was without funds needed to complete my journey and mentally exhausted from the paranoia and stress. I have grown thru 3 years of therapy, meditation, and self-discovery. Sweden accepted my application for asylum and for some time I could sleep and breathe in peace.

It has come to my attention that my family has discovered my location. With the shame that I have brought upon them from my absence, the best case scenario upon returning to Sudan would be imprisonment and abuse – until death. The worst case, and most likely, scenario would be a contest of which family member would take the honor of ending my life thus washing the shame off of the family name.

Sweden and my small community of wonderful friends have given me something I never thought was possible, something many women in Sudan are unable to fathom. Sweden gave me a path to create and live life as I choose.

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I can now walk with my chin up and smile as a woman. I have chosen to live a life of honor, love and pursue happiness in all of my endeavors. It is with this truth and great discernment that I ask for my case for asylum be removed from the process.

I am alive and I am thriving! I have grown thru so much pain for my journey to stop now. I will not allow anyone or anything to interfere with my peace of mind and freedom of choice ever again.

Sweden is now forever a part of me, my life and my life's journey. And now it is time that I complete what I started and reach my destination.

I am asking that you advise me on my options with Migrationsverket.

(1) I am requesting a *Letter Of Good Standing* that notates my independent efforts to learn the language, earn wages, pay taxes and secure an apartment in the Swedish Society.

(2) I am requesting guidance and support to safely complete my final **Flight For Freedom**. I know that I am able to leave and seek asylum elsewhere – I will readily make myself available, by any means necessary, to complete this task.

Exiting Sweden as a *Woman-Without-A-Country* and seeking asylum in another will require support and endorsements from Migrationsverket would be a welcomed addition to solidify my Positive Status in Swedish Society.

I seek to depart Sweden on my **Flight For Freedom** on or by **March 15, 2021**. I am not requesting funds from Sweden. I have stood on my own and will continue to do so as long as I am Free.

I would like to (a) have my tax returns from 2020 to be processed before my departure and (b) a letter from Migrationsverket to Skatteverket to help expedite the process. These collective efforts would be highly appreciated during this sensitive time.

I eagerly await your favorable reply and are ready to discuss this at any time. I will make myself readily available to do whatever is required to complete my journey and begin what started as only a dream to never be beaten or abused again.
